"A fine vintage in Margaret River for reds, and this classic blend hits the mark. Blackberry and dark plum aromatics capture the essence of the style. The medium bodied palate is elegant yet plush, with fruit richness extending into a long finish. Bright red berry influences add lift, while a subtle edge of bay leaf provides complexity. Excellent wine. 93 points."



Wine Name	Fermoy Wilyabrup Cabernet Merlot	Aroma	Blueberry, blackberry and red plum fruits lead into savoury notes of cocoa, tobacco leaf and bay leaf.
Vintage	2022 – a classic Margaret River vintage with a warm and dry ripening period moderated by afternoon sea-breezes and cool nights.	Palate	The medium-weighted palate unfolds in layers of blue and red berries, cooking herbs, cocoa powder, and delicate oak spice. A light-footed, yet juicy mid-palate is supported by a framework of fine, elegant tannin which add structure and length.
